Inspire Schedule Change Policy

Students at Inspire are enrolled in a year-long program and should plan accordingly. Inspire does not offer one semester-long courses. Students are placed in their classes based on graduation requirements and counselor review of transcripts, prerequisite fulfillment, and student input during the course selection process.

Students can drop and add classes for the first two weeks of each semester without prior approval from teachers. For the next two weeks, students can change their classes and must fill out the "Request to Drop a Class" form. After the first four weeks of the semester, students can request to drop a class but will receive an "F" in that course (at the teacher's discretion).

Beyond the first four weeks of each semester, students cannot change their schedule without a *serious and compelling reason*. Changes that are requested without a serious or compelling reason must be done through Administration.
